## INSTRUCTIONS for Feb. 24, 2018 ARIZONA CITY DAZE PARADE

**Entry Form:** There is no fee for parade participation. You will receive a confirmation E-mail or phone call from the parade coordinator within a week of receiving your entry. (If no confirmation, please use the “Questions/Help contacts” below to check your entry status.) Entry forms must be received by

Monday, Feb. 19, 2018 for parade administration purposes. Entries arriving later than Monday, Feb. 19, will be placed at the end of the parade and will not be eligible for judging. Make sure the description is provided on your entry application. The announcer can then best share “your story” during the parade.

**Tuesday of Parade Week:** On Tues., Feb. 20, your entry contact person will receive an e-mail (or phone call if no E-mail is listed) giving your parade line-up number. Your contact person can then notify your entry’s participants of this number and line-up location and time...intersection of Laredo Rd. and Concordia between 8-8:45 a.m. Sat., Feb. 24.

**Parade Day:** Check-in station will open on Sat., Feb. 24, 2018 at 7:30 a.m. at the corner of Laredo Rd and Concordia. Person in charge of entry must sign in and get placard to display on left side of entry during the parade. Line-up will start at 8 a.m. along Laredo Rd.

- The parade will begin at 9 a.m.
- Parade route begins at Sunland Gin Rd. and Santa Cruz and proceeds South on Sunland Gin Rd. to Hartigan Ln. The Arizona City Daze activities are on Alsdorf Rd.
- Judging during the parade will be on the east side of Sunland Gin Rd. near the First Baptist Church parking lot. Any parade performance time is limited to a maximum of one minute and must be performed in front of the judge’s stand. (Parade winners will be announced from the Arizona City Daze entertainment stage just off Alsdorf Rd. at approximately noon.)
- Candy can **ONLY** be distributed by entrants walking along the sidelines; **no** candy thrown from entry in street.
- Parade entrants must not be under the influence or consume alcoholic beverages or drugs at any time during the parade.
- The parade committee reserves the right to deny an entry or remove an entry at any time.

### Judging Categories

- COMMERCIAL – entry used to advertise a business
- MARCHING – entry for any music group, drill team, or youth group
- COMIC – clown or any humorous entry
- CIVIC – entry sponsored by a non-profit civic group
- YOUTH – youth/youth group walking or riding on a float, vehicle, (bike, trike, wagon)
- FLOATS – all floats
- MOTOR CYCLE/4 WHEELER
- CLASSIC VEHICLE
- GRAND CHAMPION -2 Awards: one youth, one adult

### Judging Criteria

- Theme (*Honoring Everyday Heros*): 1-20 pts
  - Overall Appearance: 1-30 pts
  - Originality & Creativity: 1-15 pts
  - Music (Canned 1-10 pts, Live 10-20 pts) 1-20 pts
  - Crowd Appeal: 1-15 pts
- Total Possible Points: 100 pts
